Whitby to Scarborough Race 1600hrs Friday 7th June 2024

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS 2021-2024, the prescriptions of the RYA, The International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea, and the following sailing instructions.

2 Conditions of Entry

This event is open to members of NECRA.

3 Handicaps

Results shall be calculated using NERR handicaps.

4 Notices to Competitors

Notices will be posted in the foyer of Whitby Yacht Club. Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted not later than 90 minutes before the start.

5 Classes

NECRA results there will be the 3 standard NECRA classes.

6 Signals made Ashore

Any signals made ashore will be displayed at WYC Race Station lighting system.

7 Protests

Protests, accompanied with a fee of £5, must be submitted by 2100hrs, Friday 7th June 2024 to Scarborough Yacht Club.

8 Radio Communication

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

9 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the race at their own risk. See WS rule 4 Decision to Race. The organisers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during or after this event.

10 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.

11 Safety

Boats will comply with NECRA safety regulations *WS 4 plus prescriptions*

12 Whitby Rock & Upgang Rocks

Attention is drawn to an area of rocks extending well offshore to the East of the Harbour Entrance and also Upgang Rocks situated seaward of Upgang Ravine, west of the Race Station. They are weed covered and have a charted depth of 1 metre at MLWS with seas breaking on them in strong N winds. Please see the attached reproduction of the Admiralty Chart for further details

13 Retirements

Any boat retiring from the race must inform the Race Committee at the destination Club.

15 VHF Channels

Scarborough Race Control and Whitby Race Station will operate on VHF CH M1/37.

16 Start Line

South to north transit marked by two white triangles situated above and behind the Race Station. The line extends approximately 2-3 cables seawards to the limit mark which is mark (A) of the course and may be tide borne to the east or west of the line.

WYC Buoy P to Starboard,
WYC Buoy S to Starboard
Whitby North Cardinal (Whitby Bell Buoy) to Starboard,
SYC No3 to Port
SYC No2 to port

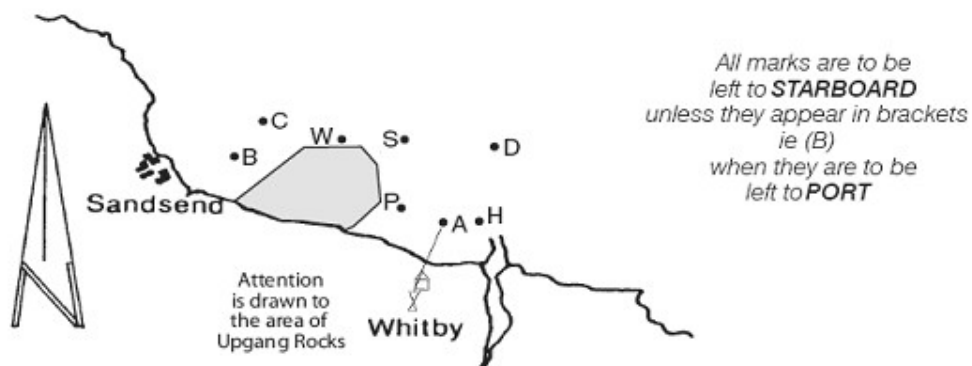
21 Finish Line
